

34% of employers in Austria say applicants lack either the hard skills (29%) or human strengths (5%) they need.







Adopting Integrated Talent Strategies

Total Workforce Index™

The Total Workforce Index (TWI) measures the relative ease of sourcing, hiring and retaining a workforce in competing labor markets around the world.

What is Scored:

The Total Workforce Index scores each market on more than 90 unique factors which are tracked for 75 global workforce markets.

Indicators:

Each statistical factor is carefully weighted and grouped under one of four categories that provide the best indicators for talent:





Segmenting the Data:

The TWI segments data by contingent and permanent workers to provide deeper insights rather than clustering into a broad demographic analysis.
